Lockhart School librarian Merle Vanterpool was extremely grateful and said the students will benefit greatly from the donation. "This gift will help in the promoting of literacy amongst our future leaders as it provides our students equal access to resources and inspire a lifetime of learning," said Vanterpool.

According to Vanterpool, the monies will be used to purchase magazine subscriptions for publications such as Highlights, Ranger Rick, Click and Sports Illustrated for Kids, which will encourage the students to visit the library more often. The funds will also be used to purchase robots which teach hands-on coding skills, another tool to motivate students to visit the library regularly.

Proceeds from the donation came from Project Promise's 2018 Havana Nights fundraiser. After hurricanes Irma and Maria in 2017, O'Reilly pledged to donate ten percent of the proceeds to one school in St. Thomas, and one school in St. Croix. Lew Muckle Elementary was selected as the school on St. Croix. During the St. Thomas trip, Medina also donated several books to all three Little Free Library locations on the island.
